

Qualifications of nominees

1. EGSA Certified
 - A qualified nominee for the TOYA must hold a current EGSA certification. This qualification will ensure that the nominee has a significant level of commitment to our industry.
2. Employed by an EGSA member company
 - A qualified nominee for the TOYA must be currently active as a member of a generator field service team with an EGSA member company.

Placing a nomination

- 1. Nomination for the annual TOYA should be made by the technician's immediate manager or an appointed officer of the company.
- 2. The nomination form must include the following:
 - a. Name of the nominee
 - b. Date of EGSA certification
 - c. Date of hire of nominee
 - d. Years of service in the generator industry
 - e. Brief summary detailing why the nominee should be considered for the TOYA
 - i. Items may include: a compelling story, service beyond the call of duty, mentoring newer technicians, training, stellar customer service, giving back to the industry, etc.
- 3. There may only be one nominee for TOYA from any company.
- 4. Nominations for the annual TOYA may be submitted to the DD appointed TOYA subcommittee through the first Friday of June.



Note: Companies submitting a nominee must be aware that if their candidate is voted the Technician of the Year, the nominating company will be responsible to cover travel expenses for their nominee to the Spring EGSA Convention in order to receive his/her award.

Selection Process

- 1. The DD appointed TOYA subcommittee will read all the submitted nominations.
 - a. The TOYA subcommittee will eliminate disqualified nominees, if any.
 - b. The TOYA subcommittee will select the top 5 nominees from all the submissions.
 - c. The TOYA subcommittee will submit the top 5 nominees to the DD Leadership Tribe
- 2. The DD Leadership Tribe and the TOYA Subcommittee will collaborate and select the 'Top 3' nominees
- 3. The 'Top 3' TOYA nominees will be presented to the EGSA membership at large via the Sept/Oct Powerline magazine
 - a. The Sept/Oct Powerline magazine will include a brief bio and the nominating summary for each of the 'Top 3' TOYA nominees.
 - b. The Sept/Oct Powerline magazine will include instructions for voting
 - i. Only one vote may be cast by each voter
 - ii. Votes may be submitted until last Friday in November
- 4. Voting will be tabulated and the Technician of the Year will be announced in the Jan/Feb Powerline magazine.
 - a. First and second runner-ups will also be announced in the Jan/Feb Powerline magazine



Awards

- 1. The EGSA Technician of the Year will receive the following awards:
 - a. A plaque engraved with the TOY's name and company's name
 - b. A gift suitable for a technician (test tool, hand tools, etc. – we suggest soliciting a sponsor for this gift – approx. value \$300)
 - c. Accommodations at the Spring EGSA Convention (we suggest soliciting a sponsor to cover the conference expenses)
- 2. The first runner-up will receive:
 - a. A gift suitable for a technician (same as above - we suggest soliciting a sponsor for this gift – approx. value \$150)
- 3. The second runner-up will receive:
 - a. A gift suitable for a technician (same as above - we suggest soliciting a sponsor for this gift – approx. value \$75)
