



## Guidance on Nomination of Directors

A potential Board candidate to be considered, must have accomplished three (3) of the five (5) items listed below:

- a. Held a position as EGSA Committee Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary or Chair of an EGSA Working Group or Subcommittee with the previous five (5) years;
- b. Speaker at an EGSA Conference or Committee Meeting in the past five (5) years.
- c. Been an EGSA Rowley School Instructor, authored a paper (Powerline Magazine article) or book chapter within the last 5 years.
- d. From a Member Company in Good Standing. ***(This criteria is mandatory for consideration)***.
- e. Has attended at least 7 EGSA Conferences within the previous five (5) years, and always participated in EGSA Committee Meetings. ***(This criteria is mandatory for consideration)***.

### **NOTES:**

- (1). Must be from a company that does not have a current employee on the EGSA Board (also, no two Board Members can be linked to a common parent company.)
- (2). Because the involvement in, and commitment to, the Association is such an important guidepost in the selection process, it is not a good idea to nominate new or relatively new members of the Association to serve on the Board.
- (3). It is also important to consider and nominate individuals from the various Membership categories (Manufacturer, Manufacturer's Representative, Distributor, etc.) as outlined in the EGSA Bylaws – Article III, Section 2.
- (4). Please note that items d. and e. listed above are mandatory for a nomination.
