

NOTICE TO USERS OF EGSA CERTIFIED TECHNICIAN LOGO MATERIALS AND ARTWORK

The EGSA Certified Electrical Generator Systems Technician logo, uniform patch and related logo items are symbols of a program that clearly demonstrate a technician's high level of professional achievement. EGSA asks that you do not diminish the value of this program—or Technicians' achievements—by misuse or unauthorized distribution of the EGSA Certified Technician logo items and artwork.

Each Certified Technician has worked long and hard to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to pass the rigorous EGSA Technician Certification test. By doing so, they have earned the exclusive right to wear and use the uniform patch and related logo items and EGSA has granted them a license to do so. Likewise, employers of Certified Technicians have the right to promote their employment of Certified Technicians to help foster excellent relationships with their Certified Technicians, their customers and their clients and to help grow their businesses. EGSA may grant a license to employers of Certified Technicians that wish to use EGSA Certified Technician logo-related materials.

The distribution of Certified Technician certificates, uniform patches and logo items is strictly controlled by EGSA and Ferris State University. There is information below that outlines our authority to protect the technicians' status, the certification program and the patch and logo items. However, we also ask for everyone's assistance to prevent the use of the patch by unauthorized persons and to help prevent individuals who are not certified from claiming that they are certified.

- EGSA Certified Technicians should give a copy of both of their certificates (wallet-sized and wall-sized) to their employer so that people making inquiries about certification status can rest assured that a technician is indeed certified. EGSA Certified Technicians should carry their wallet-sized certificate with them at all times.
- Patches or logo items must never be given to non-certified technicians. Doing so diminishes the value and the importance of the EGSA Certification Program, the patch, and the individual EGSA Certified Technician's achievement.
- If a non-certified technician is seen wearing a patch or logo item or is representing himself in any way to be an EGSA Certified Technician, please contact EGSA with the name and contact information for that individual so that we can take action to protect and maintain the value of the EGSA Certification Program. We pledge that we will not divulge your name as we investigate.

Copyright and Trademarks

EGSA applied to the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and the U.S. Copyright Office to acquire copyrights for all certification-related materials and items. These materials and items include logos and logo items (uniform patches, baseball caps, decals, etc.). Any unauthorized use or copying of these materials is a violation of Federal law.

Use of "Certified" Title and materials

Individuals—Only individuals who hold a current and valid EGSA certificate may identify themselves as an "EGSA Certified Electrical Generator Systems Technician" and only EGSA Certified Technicians may use certification-related materials (i.e., the uniform patch, logos, etc.) pursuant to a license from EGSA.

Employers—Only firms who currently employ EGSA Certified Technicians who hold a current and valid certificate may use the "We Employ..." logo and related materials pursuant to a license from EGSA.

Professional Conduct

EGSA Certificate holders and other users of EGSA certification-related materials shall not engage in any behavior that may tend to bring disrepute upon, or cause harm to, EGSA or the EGSA Certification Program. This includes unauthorized altering, copying, or distribution of EGSA Certified Technician materials (uniform patches, logos and logo items) to individuals who are not EGSA Certified. EGSA may impose disciplinary action, including revocation of a Certification, in its discretion and in the best interests of EGSA and/or the EGSA Certification Program.
